Summary of Motions Introduced (*New Legislation*)

Council File 23-0002-S24, Governors 2023-24 State Budget Proposal / Film and Television Tax Credit Program Extension / Small Productions Support / Refundable Tax Credits (*Krekorian – Blumenfield*): Introduced January 27, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for The Governor’s 2023-24 state budget proposal to extend funding to the Film and Television Tax Credit Program for five more years and make the tax credits refundable.

Council File 23-0002-S23, SB 2 (Portantino) / State Legislation / United States Supreme Court Decision / New York State Rifle and Pistol Association v. Bruen (*Park - Krekorian*): Introduced January 25, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for SB 2 (Portantino) which expresses the intent of the Legislature to enact legislation to address

the United States Supreme Court's New York State Rifle & Pistol Association v. Bruen decision.

Take Action:

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Council File 23-0102, Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) Activities / Quarterly Reports (Park – Krekorian): Introduced January 27, 2023 and referred to Trade, Travel, and Tourism Committee. The motion is requesting the Chief Executive Officer of the Los Angeles World Airports to provide quarterly reports to the Trade, Travel and Tourism Committee on the status of department activities.

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Council File 23-0100, Sustainability Initiatives / Information Sharing Practices / Port of Los Angeles (POLA) / Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) (McOsker – Yaroslavsky): Introduced January 27, 2023 and referred to Trade, Travel, and Tourism Committee. The motion is requesting the Port of Los Angeles and Los Angeles World Airports to report on their information sharing practices related to sustainability initiatives, including but not limited to emerging technologies or policies, lessons learned on the efficacy of current initiatives, and coordination with other regional sustainability initiatives.

Take Action:

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Council File 23-0098, Charter Amendment I / Contracting Limit / Los Angeles Administrative Code / Section 10.2 / Amendment (*Krekorian – Harris-Dawson*): Introduced January 27, 2023 and referred to Council. Motion is instructing the City Attorney to prepare and present an ordinance that updates and modernizes Section 10.2 to raise the written contracting requirement for amounts over \$5,000 to \$25,000.

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Council File 23-1200-S5, Elizabeth Zamora / Los Angeles City Planning Commission / Commission Appointment (*Mayor*): Introduced January 31, 2023 and referred to Planning and Land Use Management Committee. Mayor report is relative to the appointment of Elizabeth Zamora to the Los Angeles City Planning Commission, for the term ending June 30, 2023.

Take Action:

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Council File 23-0111, Unarmed Crisis Response / Performance Assessment / Office of Unarmed Response and Safety (*Harris-Dawson – McOsker – Hutt – Lee – Price*): Introduced February 1, 2023 and referred to Personnel, Audits, and Hiring Committee; Public Safety Committee. Motion is requesting that the City Controller report to the Personnel, Audits, and Hiring Committee on the findings of the assessment. The findings should include an analysis of these programs related to the performance standards and metrics set forth by the Office of Unarmed Response and Safety.

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Council File 23-0104, Small Housing Provider Assistance Program / Mom and Pop Housing Provider Payment / COVID-19 Pandemic / Eviction Defense Programs / Housing Preservation / Acquisition (Blumenfield – McOsler – Park – Rodriguez – Lee): Introduced January 31, 2023 and referred to Budget, Finance and Innovation Committee; Housing and Homelessness Committee. Motion is instructing the Los Angeles Housing Department (LAHD), with the assistance of the City Administrative Office (CAO) and the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), to establish a minimum \$10 million Small Housing Provider Assistance Program to provide payment directly to housing providers who incurred debt due to rental arrears during the course of the pandemic, and report back on recommendations on the program parameters that provides financial assistance to “mom and pop” housing providers, and including the ability to preserve housing and mitigating the sale of housing to corporations.
